RAIN WATER HARVESTING

Maharishi Vidya Mandir, Hyderabad has taken the necessary initiatives for the implementation of Rainwater harvesting mechanism in the school premises. The school provides pure certified RO water for drinking. Apart from drinking water the remaining requirement is supplied by the main source of water supply – borewell. The campus area of the school sprawls around 9 acres. More than 50% of the area is open towards playground and bus parking. The land topography is such that the entire ground slopes towards the North East corner. Owing to this aspect, there is a rainwater harvesting pit 20ft long, 10ft wide and 10ft deep. The rooftop rain water outlets are interconnected through a network of pipes and collection chambers which lead to rain water harvesting pit where the water gets filtered before seeping into the ground to enhance the underground water table. After implementation of the rainwater harvesting pit there was a remarkable rise in the water levels. Prior to this there was a scarcity in the borewell during summers. But after implementation there was never a problem even during peak summer.

RECYCLING OF WATER

The school always emphasizes on saving the environmental resources. The students are sufficiently educated and made aware of the need to save the natural resources and judicious use of them. In this connection the school has adopted a system to recycle water. The water outflow from the hand wash sinks is diverted through pipes to water the plants. Also the water used to mop the corridors is directed through a network of pipes to the filtration pits. The waste settles at the bottom and the filtered water is directed to water the plants.

The students forms teams and ensure that all these mechanisms are functioning and ensure that all the individuals in the school respect them. Also any leakages/damages and immediately attended and hence the values of sensible and judicial usage of resources is instilled among students. The Water management committee of the school comprising of 12 students and two coordinating teachers takes turns every week to ensure there is no wastage of water and the recycling is adhered to.

WASTE SEGREGATION

Waste management forms an integral part of the school activities. Maharishi Vidya Mandir, Hyderabad believes that it is very important to sensitize its students about waste management and its disposal in a hygienic and scientific manner. Awareness programmes are conducted from time to time educating students on the importance of waste segregation. Waste segregation refers to the separation of dry and wet waste, which paves the way for other concepts of waste management like composting, recycling and incineration. The main aim is to reduce waste from landfills and eventually prevent land, water and air pollution.

Every classroom is provided with 2 bins – green for wet waste/ bio-degradable, blue for dry waste. At the pockets of each corridor there are 2 big bins (biodegradable & non-biodegradable).

Students are trained to dispose waste accordingly. The sub-staff are sufficiently trained in this respect to assist students to segregate waste at the main source (the classroom). There are two composting pits in the campus at the far end of the campus measuring 5ft in length, 5ft in breadth and 5ft deep which are operated alternately. The biodegradable waste is hygienically disposed into the composting pit. The manure so obtained from the composting pit is used as a fertilizer for the plants. The dry waste is collected by the local municipality on a daily basis. Students are also encouraged to conduct awareness programs in their locality and continue to practice the segregation where ever they are-at school, home or any other public place. The school Waste management committee comprising of 10 students and 4 coordinating teachers ensures that everyone in the campus adheres to the methods of proper waste disposal.

PLANTATION

Maharishi Vidya Mandir, Hyderabad practices a tradition of adding Indian native plants every year. The native plants in the campus are – Neem, Mango, Guava, Indian Gooseberry, Indian Blackberry, Jackfruit. Coming to plants, the campus is enriched with medicinal herbs like the holy Basil, Henna, Hibiscus, Rose etc. The School boundary is fenced with beautiful yellow Tecomastans. The School every year participates in the plantation programme called 'Harita Haaram' where apart from planting saplings in the school campus every child is gifted with a sapling. At this juncture we are proud to say that we at Maharishi Vidya Mandir, Hyderabad have adopted a tradition of gifting any dignitaries visiting our school with the holy Basil. Students are also encouraged to plant a sapling on their birthdays. Eco clubs of the school comprising of at least 12 students, 2 coordinating teachers ensure all activities are carried out as planned.

The management, staff and students of Maharishi Vidya Mandir, Hyderabad are ever ready to ensure the sensible and judicious use of resources and also play a very active role to imbibe a sense of environmental protection in their localities.
